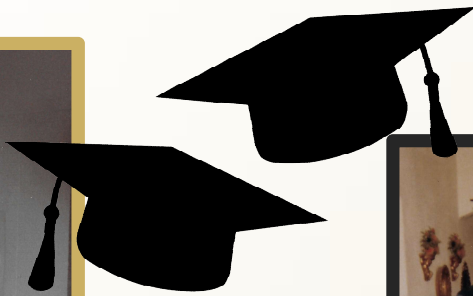

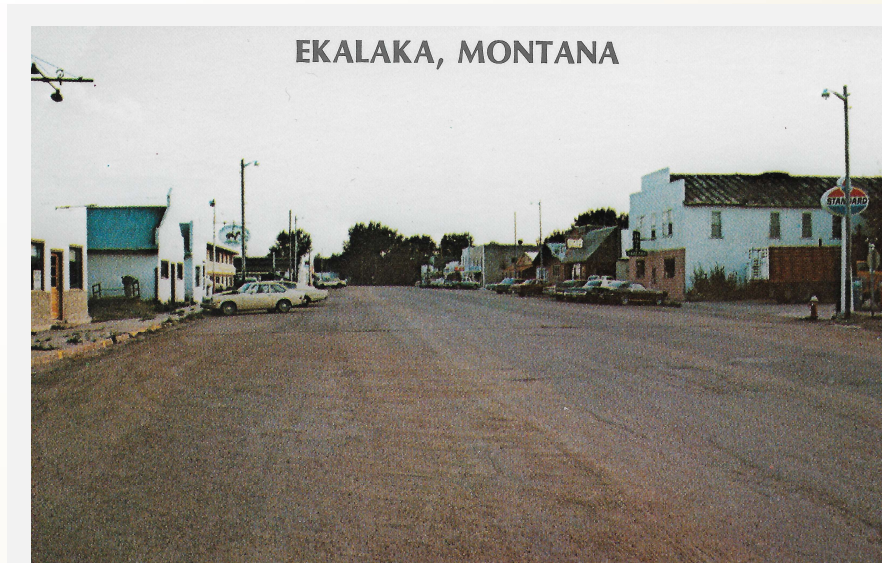

Pastor Pickens Ordained Here

An Ordination Service was held at Congregational Church on Sunday, April 1, 1928, for Pastor Doyle Pickens.

Pastor Pickens was questioned by examining council of twelve men, 10 pastors and two laymen on the afternoon of April 1st. He was examined for two and one-half to three hours and after questioning a vote of examining council was taken which proved unanimous and Pastor Pickens recommended to the Church for ordination.

Walter Stieg sang a melody of special solemness for Pastor Pickens. Rev. LaRue Goetz of Ismarok, North Dakota, brought the message in the evening. Rev. Randy Newton gave charge to the newly ordained Rev. Doyle Pickens and the church.

After the service there was a time of refreshment and fellowship.

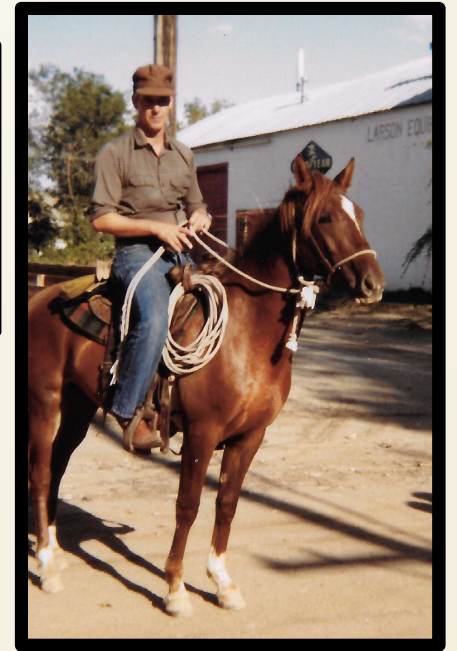
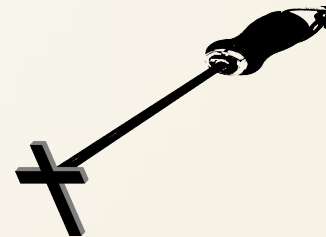
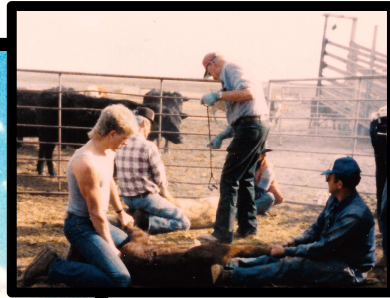

Picken's Farewell Meeting

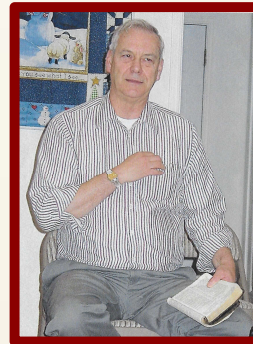
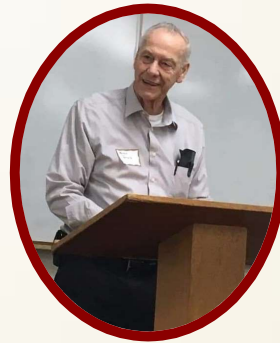
The membership and friends of the Ekalaka Congregational Church gathered between the church and parsonage Sunday afternoon, following the farewell sermon
